- → Depression
- → Absence from school
- → Hopelessness
- → Poor self-image
- → Social isolation
- → Increase in lying
- → Poor understanding of personal boundaries
- → Self-blame
- → Violence towards pets or younger siblings
- → May use violence to try to solve problems.

Abuse is hurting another person physically, emotionally, or verbally. Physical injuries are not the only type of abuse.

Sexual Assault or Harassment is any unwanted sexual contact or conduct.

Stalking is a course of conduct directed at a specific person that would cause a reasonable person fear.

Intimate partner violence, sexual assault and stalking are used to exert power and control over someone.

What is Domestic Violence?

Domestic violence is a pattern of abusive behaviors used by one individual to control or exert power over another individual inthe context of an intimate relationship.

Patterns involve a variety of abusive behaviors which usually increase in frequency and intensity over time.

Abusive Behaviors include:

- Verbal assault & threats
- Intimidation & isolation
- Physical & sexual assault
- Destruction of property
- Violence directed toward victim's loved ones or pets
- Behaviors that cause fear
